We Salute Those Who Gave All

Memorial Day is not about the first day of summer, family barbecues, or sales at retail stores. It is not even about honoring veterans or those currently serving in the armed forces. We made it home. Rather, it is about those that answered their country's call to support and defend the constitution and didn't make it home. Those who wrote out a check to our country for "up to and including my life"; and that check was cashed. From the American Revolution to today, over 1.2 million service members have made the ultimate sacrifice.

One of them was S/Sgt Clifford Sims. Born Clifford Pittman in 1942, he was orphaned at a young age and spent much of his childhood homeless and living in an abandoned bus while attending a nearby school. He was finally adopted at age 13 and enlisted in the Army in 1961. He deployed to Vietnam with the 101st Airborne Division's Delta Company, 2nd Battalion, 501st Infantry "Raiders" in late 1967. On 21 Feb 1968, S/Sgt Sims was a squad leader during a battle that rivaled the hottest of the war. His first act of heroic leadership that day was to lead his squad in a furious attack against an enemy force that had pinned down the 1st Platoon. His squad's actions enabled the platoon to regain the initiative. They were then ordered to move to a position to provide cover fire for the company command group and link up with another platoon that was under heavy enemy pressure. While enroute he detected an ammunition storage area that was ablaze and directed his men away from it before it blew, ensuring only two squad members were injured in the ensuing blast and undoubtably saving numerous lives. Continuing on, he detected the unmistakable sound of a booby trap being triggered. Violently yelling "Get back! Get Back," he threw himself on the devise and absorbed the full force of continued on next page Cont. from page 1

the explosion with his body. His selfless sacrifice saved the lives of five others. In December 1969, Clifford's widow, Mary, accepted his posthumous Medal of Honor from the Vice President of the United



States. When S/Sgt
Sims threw himself on
the explosive devise, he
did not think about or
care what color those
around him were. They
were his comrades in
arms; that was all that
mattered. (To read S/

On Memorial Day in 1982, President Ronald Reagan said: "Our first obligation to them and ourselves is plain enough: The

United States and the freedom for which it stands, the freedom for which they died, must endure and prosper. Their lives remind us that freedom is not bought cheaply. It has a cost; it imposes a burden. And just as they whom we commemorate were willing to sacrifice, so too must we...."

Today, we are dismayed to see the spread of Critical Race Theory, the 1619 Project and other political propaganda throughout the military. Those teachings claim "white supremacy" is a major threat to the U.S. They ignore the violent, destructive riots of BLM, ANTIFA and other radicals throughout 2020 and extending until today. These radical beliefs are rooted in Marxism and seek to destroy capitalism, religion, the nuclear family, and they wish to punish anyone who does not support the "party line".

As I reflect on all those who have made the ultimate sacrifice for our country, the U.S. Constitution and the ideals that America was founded upon (which we have continually progressed toward realizing over the past 250 years), I can not help but fear we are now regressing. Instead of moving forward toward our long sought after goal of unity and judging people by their character instead of the color of their skin, we are now returning to divisions by race and identity, and distrust of each other and our government.

Why would they write a check to their country for "up to and including my life" to serve and defend a country they have been indoctrinated to believe was founded on slavery and remains irredeemably racist, evil and oppressive?

- 5. Private dinner with about a dozen attendees Thursday evening, May 27.



Boots On The Ground Perspectives

- From a current USAFA appointee to Lt Col Lohmeier:

"I am from a very blue county in XXXXX, and have been very conservative my entire life. With that said, I'm very well acquainted with the intolerant left and their anticonservative rhetoric. I have received an appointment to USAFA for the Class of 2025, and will be heading to Colorado Springs in about 3 weeks for I-Day. Your section about CRT and the progressive agenda at the service academies is spot on. Even just as an appointee, we are required to sit through "EVERFI Diversity Training Courses." It is a series of videos talking about racism, and promoting BLM. All of the videos featured actors in different situations that were meant to show "racism". One section particularly frustrated me, where it showed a Hispanic man talking with two women about going to a "Black Lives Matter rally." A white man walks into the room and joins the conversation. The man chimes in with his opinion that "All Lives Matter" and that he does not support the BLM organization. The video then asks you to make a choice as to what the Hispanic man should say in response.
