"As a current Active Duty Service Member, I can tell you that the military has become weak and woke at the leadership level."

"It's no longer the apolitical military the American people can count on. I'm done when I hit my retirement a year from now."

"As someone that's currently active for 19 years, the route that the military has taken would absolutely make me not want to do it again. I've had so many first term enlisted ask questions and opinions from me. Not because of going to war but because of politics and policies put in place."

"After 20 years of commissioned service, I tell folks all the time-- no matter how woke you think the armed forces are, it is much worse."

"My dad and father in law both served in the military, and now my son-in-law is in the Army. He says wokeness is killing the morale of the enlisted men."

"The majority of military members don't THINK the Pentagon has become politicized... they KNOW it for a fact. I've got a pair of sons in the Army. Some of the stories they tell me about the woke briefings they have to sit through..."

"My son is due to retire from the Navy after 25 years. He told me that due to these political policies he can't wait to leave. I'm just glad he is at the end of his career and not the beginning."

"I just retired from the Marine Corps after 20 years last year and it's getting out of hand. You've got leadership that doesn't care about anything except these woke policies. I know lots of Marines that are getting out because they are tired of it, as well as Marines, who wanted to do more than 20 years but they are tired of the woke culture."

"I'm retiring in July after 22 years 100% because of the new woke BS. We spend a significant amount of time dedicated to woke agenda and I've had enough. gender identification acceptance, pronouns, etc. I honestly DO NOT care what the person is or thinks they are, but at the same time I don't want an agenda FORCED down my throat. I believe what I believe and other are free to believe what they want. Just let me do my job of defending this nation."



"Same here. I'm almost able to retire from active service and can't wait."

"24 years in, about to retire. My son wanted to follow in my footsteps and join. I've discouraged him (his choice) from doing so. It's a mess fight now."

"Well, my son has been in the USAF for 14 years. He just visited us and said the morale is the worst he has ever seen. He said they are getting overwhelmed with a focus via training and propaganda on LGBTQ indoctrination. He is getting out after his next 4 years is up."

"My son, who wanted to be a Marine his entire youth, left after 5 years, disgusted with the new 'woke' Marines."

"A friend of mine has a son in the AF that is an officer. He has a masters degree in Aeronautical Engineering. He told his dad he is retiring in a few months and that it can't happen soon enough He says that the "woke" garbage being shoved down their throats is sickening, and he can't take it anymore. He says there are many officers and enlisted that feel the same way and will be leaving the service. As bad as the Russian military has performed in Ukraine, I doubt if we could even defeat them on a battlefield."

"I proudly served 25 years in the Army. Most Soldiers I know today, including two of my sons, are just hanging on until they hit 20, if they're close, or until their current enlistment expires. It will take massive investments of time and money to rebuild our military once this administration ends."

"I retired from the military 2 years ago and I don't want my kids joining. It was a pretty good gig for me and I'm happy to have served, but there's no way I would recommend it to anyone. Having to walk on eggshells in order to prevent ruining your career and future definitely isn't worth it now.

"My kid came out after six years, finished up his engineering degree, and told anyone who would listen to never enlist."

"My son is a Navy Lt flying Seahawks; I'm retired USAF Lt Col/ former pilot of God's gift to man, the UH-1N. I pray for the day he can leave. I could not recommend anyone join today, our oath was to the Constitution, not to ideology. USAFA '90"

"It's terrible. I retired last year from the military, 27 1/2 years, am very proud of my service. Things changing over time is to be expected, however, the changes in the past several years have been drastic & disappointing. We need to do better & change course. Will stop there."

"When I was in, they allowed transgenders and it didn't make any sense. We got talked to by an admiral and did like 10 meetings on transgender sensitivity training. I am no longer in."

"Met a young man a couple weeks ago who was medically discharged from the Army. Gave me an earful about all of the DEI training now. That is not my US military!"

"It's true. The woke agenda was a leading factor in my decision to retire after 22 years. I was seeing a new generation of Soldiers that I would not want in a foxhole with me."

"I retired after 25+ years last February. I made this life changing decision after what I deemed was CRT indoctrination. They called it something else. My inner voice became an external tirade of disagreement, and I knew this was a battle I was going to lose. Cowardly, I decided to exit with my pension intact. The problem with this is so did a great many of my cohort of technical and tactical experts. The "Great Purge" continues."

"I s surprised when my youngest son enlisted in 2012. A Black Hawk Crew Chief he was on his way to flight school when he attended a leadership class on 'What to do if your male solider becomes pregnant or has their period.' He had complained that half their time was spent in HR classes instead of training. Lack of flight hours, field training, competency in individual and collective tasks and skills. And so, much to the disappointment of this old soldier, he made the right decision, giving up his opportunity to become a pilot and got out. Today he has a degree in mathematics and a master's from Embry Riddle in Aerospace Aviation Management and Safety and is employed as the Director of Safety for a cargo airline. He and his family are doing quite well, and he certainly doesn't regret his decision. Regrettably, neither do I as his father. US Army Retired."

"It's because of the wokeness. My hubs retired after 38 years in. A fellow soldier told him he was forced to sign agreements accepting men dressing as women in the Army. The guy told his commander "I'll sign it but I'm telling you I don't agree with this." He still received a negative mark in his record just for an off the record opinion."

"25 years active duty and still work for the army as a civilian. This army is way more concerned with social issues and equity than warfighting. Discipline is lax and I sometimes think the commanders from company to brigade are severely concerned about not doing anything to get relieved, much more than training for war. I don't see this ever reversing, one reason I would not recommend service in the Army. Sad to say...."

"My son recently retired from the military. They spent more time in classes that taught political correctness than they did in flight briefs. Within a three month period, his squadron lost almost 60% of their pilots and crews. The airlines pay much better anyway."

"I'm so happy I got out in 2017. I'm proud of my service, but I would never let my kids join. Sadly, the Army has changed so much over the last decade. Not sure if we are the good guys anymore."

"We know 2 brothers who are young, patriotic, dedicated Marines who joined the corps carrying on a family legacy of service. They both fulfilled their first term of enlistment and then got out because of the indoctrination and woke ideology."

EVERY ONE OF THEM. These are people from all around the greater Washington DC many of which had parents and grandparents who were military. This is a pretty good sign that people don't want to join the new "woke" military."

"Daughter has 7yrs to retirement and she is just holding on at this point as bad as it is getting. I remember affirmative action promotions from when I was in the Army during the 80's. People with no business being in charge of anything getting promoted. One of our E5's couldn't read at a grade school level."

"I retired with 21 years of service and have worked as a contractor for the military for 20 more years. The military culture has changed dramatically in 40 years... for the worse. Standards seem to be out the window and there's very little motivation toward achieving goals. Commanders are scared to make

decisions without consulting an army of lawyers, and every decisions has to be politically correct and "woke". Those type of decision-making cycles get soldiers killed. It's no wonder kids no longer want to serve. Military vets are warning their kids and others not to join. Remove the woke and esprit de corp will return."

"My father retired from the Air Force with 30 years. I retired from the Army with 21. I still work as a contractor for the military, and I can say with great discomfort that the military I knew is no more. Physical requirements have been rolled back, aptitude tests have been dumbed down, and standards in general are waved for many categories. It scares me that soldiers have to serve under a president that doesn't value their lives nor cares about the military in general."

"I am on all branches bases, installations conducting business. Must say, as a veteran of 2 wars-conflicts, 14 years Active Duty, it is VERY discouraging and scary to see the utter lack of decorum, respect and discipline we were taught makes the greatest fighting military in the world! Is it a coincidence the USA is at its weakest point over these past 3 years? I think NOT!"

"A friend of mine's Grandson just got out of USMC Boot Camp. He went to the rifle range twice, bivouac once. diversity training the rest of the time. Sad to say that the boy feels very disappointed after his Grandfather told him what the Marines USED TO BE before he enlisted! My Buddy, his Grandpa, had no idea it had gotten that bad, me either."

"I retired from the USAF in 2009, still work on the base I retired from and trust me, the standards started getting lowered years ago. It's so sad and maddening to see the quality of young troops these days. Almost every young airman, and many NCOs, that I cross paths with look like they want to

kill themselves, have no pride in their uniforms. I don't know what's going on but it's shameful."

"As a veteran, I would not join the military today. I advise young people against it when they ask me about it. Individuals I know who are currently serving echo my sentiments. I find this incredibly sad, as I come from a line of veterans..."

"I'm a retired 5th generation officer. I'm actively encouraging my kids to pursue another path so long as people like you are running the military. There is no honor in fighting for the priorities of this admin/congress. But good luck fighting climate change with diversity."

"My family has served every generation since immigrating to this nation since the 1800s. Me and my brother are the last who will ever enlist. Thanks for ruining our honorable tradition of military service."

"I deployed twice to Afghanistan and served in the 82nd and 173rd. I am not interested in sending my children to join an organization that is headed by woke commissars who do nothing but aggressively push for "diversity" and wokeism. I will be discouraging them from joining."

"Your primary recruiting base was the sons of conservative families. You went woke and now they don't want their sons anywhere near your new fabulously diverse train wreck. Go woke Go lose the next major war."

"As a legacy American (settler, not immigrant) my family has served in the US military in every war since the Revolution. Some died, some lived to tell stories. My wife and I served in the 70's. My son did three tours in Afghanistan. All that to

"I don't know a single person that got out in the last 15 years that recommends joining right now."

"I was grateful to have served in the Army National Guard for 8 years. I have told my sons to NOT follow in my footsteps. I cannot and will not recommend to anyone to serve in today's Armed Forces."

"Males in my family have serviced since the Revolution. I'll be the last one to have a DD214. #notmychildren"

"I was enlisted from 99-07. At least 1 male from each generation served pre-dating the founding of the US in my family. It ended with me, when I barred both of my son's from joining as I watched our military become a joke. Our national defense is no longer in uniform, it's us."

"Having served in the military under President Ronald Reagan, what the left is doing to our military now with this DEI and CRT garbage, the military is an embarrassment! It's no wonder that morale and recruitment is way down!"

One of my nephews is a Navy SEAL and he is a conservative Christian. The military, by going woke, has guaranteed it'll drive off the very people normally attracted to military service."

"Fellow air force vet here. And I totally agree with your post. Our mission is to protect this country, not to learn about pronouns and victimhood. If this keeps up, the primary language of North America will be mandarin Chinese."

who demand to be something they are not. It is also absurd to allow transgender personnel into the service because of the drugs they must take to survive and the questionable mental state that they are living with. "

"There is NOT a chance in hell that I would join today's military. Ex-U.S Navy."

"Simply put, I would not voluntarily join today's politically correct military. The military exists for only one reason, defending this country by breaking things and hurting people as directed by the leaders of this country. That being said. I discouraged all 3 of my sons from enlisting. The current military is beyond broken. It has nothing to do with the enlisted or junior officers. The problem lies with the upper leadership."

"The whole thing with the COVID shot or out was nothing but a pure power play and a culling method. I was in during the anthrax shot controversy, and people who didn't take it weren't kicked out, just placed in a non-deployable status."

"Retired from the military in 2017. I will not allow my children to serve in this current climate, especially when we have a "CinC" who has a habit of putting our service members in harms way."

"Sad, I've been a contractor for almost 30 years and the quality of the military recruits are way down from even 10 years ago. At some point military officers are more concerned about making rank instead of doing what's best for our country. "21 years of service with some of the best people in the country. Now, when people ask me about whether or not to go into the military, I pretty much say not in a million years."

"I spent twelve years in the Marine Corp, but I would discourage any young person to join today under this current Biden Administration or any future Democratic Administration."

"Back in the old days, everyone in was green, and there was no need to preach about equity or racism. this is a monster of their own creation."

"My father served in the British Royal Air Force toward the end of WWII, I served 21 years in the US Army - I used to encourage young men to join, but no longer. Now I try and talk them out of it. The military that used to be a matter of patriotic pride to serve in is now a sad joke."

"I was in the ARNG for 13 years, 1 year in Afghanistan. "My son has been in the Navy for 13 years and I'm I big military supporter. Given the changes in the military I would not recommend it to people and I never thought that would be the case!"

"Retired Army, first military then civilian. I was forced to retire 4-5 years earlier than planned, because I would not be coerced into taking the shot. Greatest decision I have made in the military."

"My brother-in-law was forced, by the military, to take the jab or be dishonorably discharged after 20+ years of service and 4 tours. He didn't want to take it but ended up doing so. He now has heart problems. This is real and it's happening."

"My husband and I just got out and we have been experiencing similar health issues since. We were also gaslighted anytime we tried to get medical help where we were stationed. We were mandated to get them. Do not let anyone lie and say otherwise. To say we are angry is an understatement."

"My daughter is in the army, she fought against taking the jab all the way up until they were going to start giving dishonorable discharges to anyone that resisted. Luckily be she did give some push back, she's only had one jab, THANK GOD! We have been blessed with her having good health, and she hasn't faced any complications so far. I am still praying for God to continue to protect her. She tried to get a religious exemption, but they denied everyone that was applying for the religious exemption too. She was in a group of soldiers from every ranking you can think of getting bullied and threatened their careers and they were all yelled at and forced to take the jab. She'll be gone for deployment next year, and I would not be surprised that they'll make her get a booster when she gets her international vaccines for travel."

"My family member was discharged from the Navy because he refused. He still hasn't heard if he can get any benefits at all after nearly 11 years of exemplary service." "I'm military and was forced to get J&J and I've had weird issues ever since. All are mild thankfully. The worst part was watching everyone attack the ones strong enough to stand up to this. I always defended them."

"I got my injection while serving in the navy March 8 and for two years I experienced severe nerve pain in my whole upper left side. It was so debilitating, and I still deal with sporadic aches. It started right after getting the shot but the cause was completely disregarded. After rounds of tests and no anatomical physical evidence of what could be the cause they just threw different medications at me. The reality is more testing should have been done before making anything mandatory, and service members should not be treated like Guinea pigs. What also sucked was still having swollen lymph nodes from the shot too that are calcified, I remember my doctor just saving "come back in 6 months if you still have these I've been noticing them a lot with people who have been vaccinated" I was 22 year old young healthy woman none of what I have gone through makes sense. It was the first available round of the Pfizer shot. Anyways I used to think people were being dramatic but the proof is in the pudding."

"My son was discharged (along with 13,000 others) from the Air Force for refusing to be injected with something that does harm. He was an aviation technician on combat aircraft. I served in the Marine Corps in the 1980's. We never had to deal with this kind of evil."

"My father is now terminally ill from the anthrax vaccine that was forced on him as part of his service. Many of his fellow servicemen and women were also negatively affected. Fortunately this allowed my family to make our own judgement and decide we did not want to take the experimental vaccine. We are all perfectly fine, and proud we

"I was a hair's breadth away from joining the Navy in 2020 at the ripe age of 24. I would've shipped that June. Papers were signed, and I was in DEP. Then COVID came around, and I backed out, trusting my gut instinct about what was on the horizon. I later relented around December of 2020 because, well, I'm broke with a degree, and I wanted *some* kind of job security in this failing economy... so I hit up the Air Force. I asked the Air Force recruiter about whether or not forced vaccinations would likely be a thing. He told me, "Never. Not a chance." I knew right then and there my former instincts were correct, and I never entered into a recruiting office again. The government doesn't care about you, whether you're a citizen or a serviceman. We are all just mouths to feed and minds to mold. Nothing more than animals with pesky "beliefs" to them. It's

positively Satanic, and I thank God that I never joined."

"I was an assistant first sergeant during the mando shot time. Big Air Force came down and basically said the ppl who refused the shot were gonna get admin actions and booted. Why? Because they would become non-deployable/lack readiness. Our squadron had 8 ppl on the chopping block and kicked one out just before the Ohio lawsuit. And the funny thing about the readiness part... the ppl in the military who wanna do the weird trans stuff get a non-deploy status due to medications/ continual mental health care and surgeries. With that, they are able to stay in the service vs a person who doesn't want the covid shot. Its bs."

"My husband almost under penalty of jail time with less than a year to go before our 20 year retirement had to be forced to get it. He either got it or he would be jailed and we would lose all of our retirement."

"My husband is National Guard and was told he had to get the jab or lose his job. He said "I know it isn't ok, however I at least got the same one that was given to all the major higher ups. "It is just sad that our service members were forced into this."
