We are in a Cultural War

- . . . and, we are losing as evidenced by wide-spread student riots supporting a terrorist organization— Hamas—raising its flag on U.S. soil

- Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) is a spin-off from Critical Race Theory (CRT) and CRT is firmly rooted in Marxism
- Marxism divides people into groups and pits them against each other based on one group being the “oppressors” and the other the “oppressed”
- Today the left is using “identity” groups defined by race, gender, ethnicity, sex orientation, etc., as the “oppressed” class
- The “oppressors” are defined as being white, especially white males
- Since the “identity” group class is seen as being “oppressed”, that justifies special privileges for them as compensation for being “oppressed”
- Special privileges involve lowering standards for admission to academies, “goals” for senior level promotions, selection for high level military education, selection for key assignments, lower physical training requirements, etc.
- Special privileges create animosity, distrust, and morale problems within the rank
- Lower standards result in lower performance which then degrades combat readines
- By its nature and purpose, DEI (wokness) “divides” service members into identity groups which is opposite of “uniting” the military into cohesive teams, trusting each other for their lives

PURPOSE:

To put constitutional government back into the hands of “We the People”

HOW:

Citizen involvement at the Local, State, and National levels—emphasis on local grassroots organizations to get involved and then roll these actions into actions at state and federal levels

→ EDUCATION:

Citizens and parents should control schools, not boards, administrators, or unions

- Remove Critical Race Theory and 1619 Project teaching; insist on fact-based teaching of climate change and our national history; remove all gender identity/neutral teaching
- Elect those with traditional family-based values to school boards
- Attend and speak at school board, PTA and other school meetings
- Volunteer to assist teachers in class; attend classes; review the curriculum; monitor pedagogy
- Allow voluntary prayer in school
- Get civics back into the classroom along with math and science; require higher academic standards

→ POLITICAL:

Get involved with local government

- Elect those with traditional values as county commissioners, clerks, and serve on county committees
- Elect those with traditional values to serve as mayors, city council members, and various committees at the town and city levels
- Attend meetings at county, town, and city levels and speak out
- Require the Pledge of Allegiance to open all county, town, and city meetings
- Elections: volunteer to be a poll worker and/or watcher
- Stay informed on legislative actions at the state and national level; phone, write letters, emails, etc., to elected officials—ensure they know how you want them to vote; hold them accountable
- Present your concerns to your congressional and senate local district representatives
- Elect those with conservative values to party precinct positions to represent your local interests at the state and federal level
- Contribute to campaigns—money and/or volunteer work

→ LAW ENFORCEMENT:

Insist on the fair, equal, and consistent enforcement of the law; no double standards

- Elect sheriffs and DAs who will constitutionally enforce the rule of law and will resist state and federal mandates infringing on Constitutional Rights of citizens
- Fully support local law enforcement budgets; oppose defunding the police
- Thank your law enforcement officials both verbally and in writing for their dedicated service

→ MEDIA:

- Write to local newspapers, radio, and TV stations with facts; correct media misinformation

→ ORGANIZE:

- Organize citizens within church groups, among church groups, and outside church groups
- Attend peaceful demonstrations on key issues like schools, open borders, election integrity, 1st and 2d Amendment Rights, etc
