Changes to policies in recent years have resulted in unintentional complexities and ambiguities, making certain policies difficult to understand, comply with, and enforce. You deserve better...we owe you better.

You will receive a series of updates in the near future with clarifications to many policies, all with an eye towards the foregoing First Principles. These will include changes to DAFI 36-2903, as well as updates to how we process and evaluate medical waivers and religious accommodations. Throughout, we will remain faithful to governing law and DoD policy.
